



Water Safety Specialist Job Description

Position Summary:

This full-time exempt position is based out of Weas Engineering's Westfield, IN location and eligible for company benefits. The Water Safety Specialist will serve in multiple roles as described in the essential job functions below. Occasional overnight travel may be required. The Water Safety Specialist will report to the Water Safety Business Manager.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Supports Water Safety Business Manager in all activities.
2. Works alongside field representatives to support all water safety activities at customer sites and remotely.
3. Performs site assessments for Water Management Programs (WMP's) as described by ASHRAE 188, Centers for Medicare/Medicaid (CMS) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).
4. Completes building water system process flow diagrams
5. Assists with writing of WMP's.
6. Coordinates tower cleaning projects with subcontractor, customer and field representatives.
7. Conducts surveys with equipment support team for potable water treatment applications.
8. Collects water samples at customer sites, including occasionally in hospital patient areas.
9. Performs basic field testing of water samples.
10. Interacts with customers and prospects to sell and support Weas products and services.
11. Researches local, state and federal guidelines for secondary disinfection
12. Stays up-to-date on all industry standards and guidelines for legionella and other waterborne pathogens

Qualification Requirements:

1. Science degree or equivalent experience.
2. Strong relevant qualitative and quantitative skills.
3. Demonstrated and recognized integrity, sound character, social skills, and leadership ability.
4. Ability to multi-task.
5. Attention to detail.
6. Excellent oral and written communication skills.
